Why did you decide to bring P2 Missions and Infusion Missions under the World Changers name?

Of the three brand names, World Changers is the most well known among churches, having the largest attendance and being the oldest. The strategic decision was made to tap into those strengths to provide a positive influence on both P2 Missions and Infusion Missions by being more closely associated with the World Changers name. The same staff will continue to coordinate and serve all three ministries.

Is the type of ministry we are doing changing?

Distinctives of each brand (construction, church planting, and urban) will remain. We will continue providing ministry site experiences that past customers are used to being a part of. The number of hours spent daily serving on ministry sites remains the same.

Why did you change the World Changers logo?

Like any ministry or church that is continuing to evolve, we felt it important to evolve visually too. We look forward to entering a new era with World Changers and thought it important to help communicate that with a new look as well. We were especially intentional to continue incorporating the globe, but updating the colors and typeface, now adding symbols that represent each project type (construction, church planting, and urban).

Why did World Changers make these programming changes?

We want to be a ministry that continues to thrive and excel in providing meaningful missions experiences where students leave with a better understanding of the gospel personally and to share with others. As we evaluated this vision, we made the strategic decision to dedicate more time during the week for group leaders to invest in their students and process the mission experience. We will continue to resource and program this group time so leaders feel equipped to lead it and are not having to create their own curriculum or other resources. Our goal is for students to leave a week at World Changers with a better understanding of the gospel, having cultivated deeper relationships with their leaders and peers, and challenged to take spiritual next steps. Our staff doesn't get to go home with groups (sadly!) to continue the discipleship process, but your group leader does. We want to foster that process as much as possible while we are together.

Will there be a Speaker or Video Speaker?

There will continue to be dedicated times throughout the week where students will be led through learning and worship experiences from the platform by summer staff, coordinators, and through interactive experiences. Our desire is to further invest and elevate the group leader in discipling their students. World Changers will provide resources, curriculum, and supplies for these experiences and for leaders to lead their students into a deeper understanding of the gospel. We want to set leaders up for success as they continue discipling their students far beyond a week spent at World Changers.
